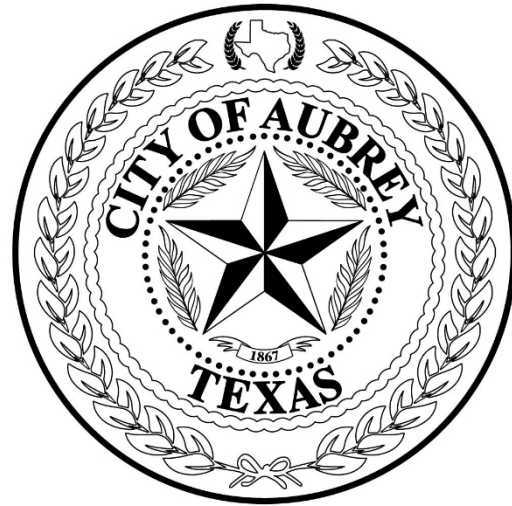

Summary

The Aubrey Police Department (APD) is continuing the Crime Victim Advocate Grant Program. This resolution authorizes our continued participation in the grant program.

Financial Summary

At this time this project's estimated cost for Fiscal Grant Year 2026 will be \$91,878.58. The City of Aubrey would be obligated to a cash match of \$21,263.58 which is paid through the managing supervisor's salary.

RESOLUTION NO. 994-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF AUBREY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) CJD eGRANT VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN JUSTICE AND TRAINING PROGRAM, FY2026 FOR THE HIRING OF A VICTIM ADVOCATE; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT AS THEAS THE CITY'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE OOG CJD eGRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The City of Aubrey finds it in the best interest of the citizens of City of Aubrey that the Victim Advocate be operated for the 2025/2026 budget year; and

WHEREAS, The City of Aubrey agrees to provide 30 percent ,matching funds for the said project as required by the Violence Against Women Justice and Training Program grant application; and

WHEREAS, The City of Aubrey agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, The City of Aubrey assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The City of Aubrey designates Charles Kreidler, City Manager, as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that The City of Aubrey approves submission of the grant application for the Victim Advocate to the Office of the Governor.
